Whether enrolled in an online class in a distance learning format or an on-site class, our ECFE teachers strive to:

Infant Classes

Our infant classes are taught by an ECFE Infant Specialist/licensed parent educator. In our infant classes, you will be able to connect with other new parents, ask questions and share ideas related to adjusting to a new baby, feeding, sleeping and more. All infant classes at this time are online. Upon registration, our infant specialist will contact you to connect you with the online class.

Toddler & Twos Classes

Toddlers and young twos are on the move and gaining independence as they explore the world around them. Early Childhood teachers will provide age specific and fun learning activities just for toddler/twos. Parent discussion will support topics related to toddler/twos development.

Birth to 5 Classes

Multi-age classes provide an opportunity for children between birth to age 5 to come together to learn and play. This class provides the opportunity for siblings to attend the same class together. A range of parenting topics and children's activities especially designed for all levels of learning can be expected.

Specialty Parent/Child Interactive Classes

Try a variety of our popular specialty classes: Music and Movement, Messy Art, STEM, Language, Literacy and Learning or try our Parent/Child Interactive Short Series: Fun with Books, Creativity and Sensory Play, Developing Language with Books, Songs and Fingerplays, or Drawing, Writing and Fine Motor Fun.
